



## TEMPORARY POLICY: COVID-19

*This temporary policy is put in place due to COVID-19.*

### Required twice per month contact with children/youth

- May be conducted virtually.
- May be conducted in person if comfortable.
- If conducted in person, follow CDC guidelines and state and local (community) mandates/advisories.
- Meeting outside is encouraged.
- Check with and respect placement's comfort level with in-person contact.
- Prescreen placement prior to visit (prescreening questions below).

### Transportation of children/youth

- May be allowed if comfortable.
- While transporting, follow CDC guidelines and state and local (community) mandates/advisories.
- Prior to transporting, check with and respect placement's comfort level with in-person contact.
- Prescreen placement prior to transporting (prescreening questions below).

### Prescreen Questions

1. Is anyone living in your household sick?
2. To the best of your knowledge, does anyone in your household have a temperature above 100.4?
3. Does the child/youth or anyone in your household have any of the following symptoms: fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, new loss of smell or taste, and/or gastrointestinal symptoms (including nausea, diarrhea, or vomiting)?
