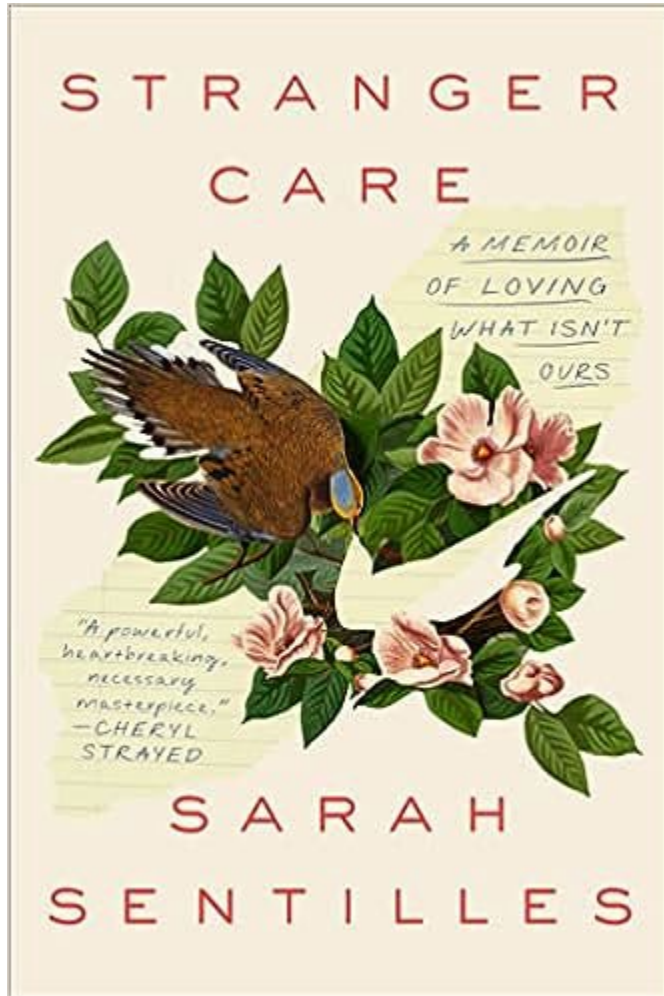

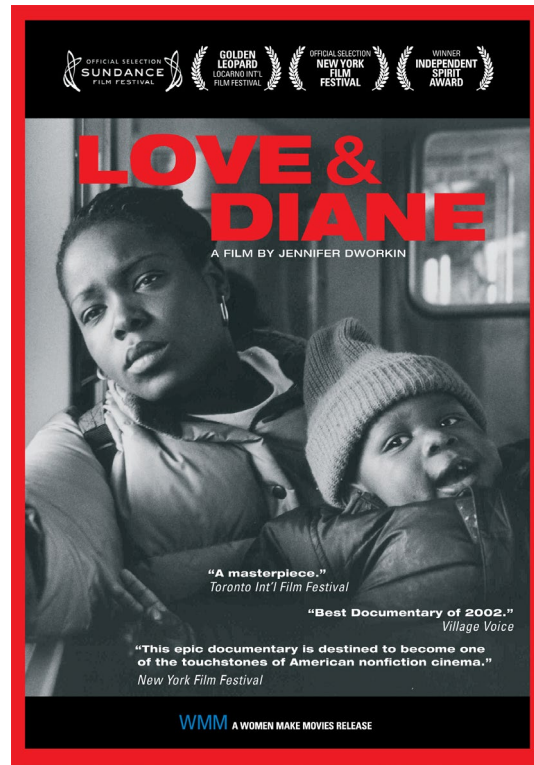

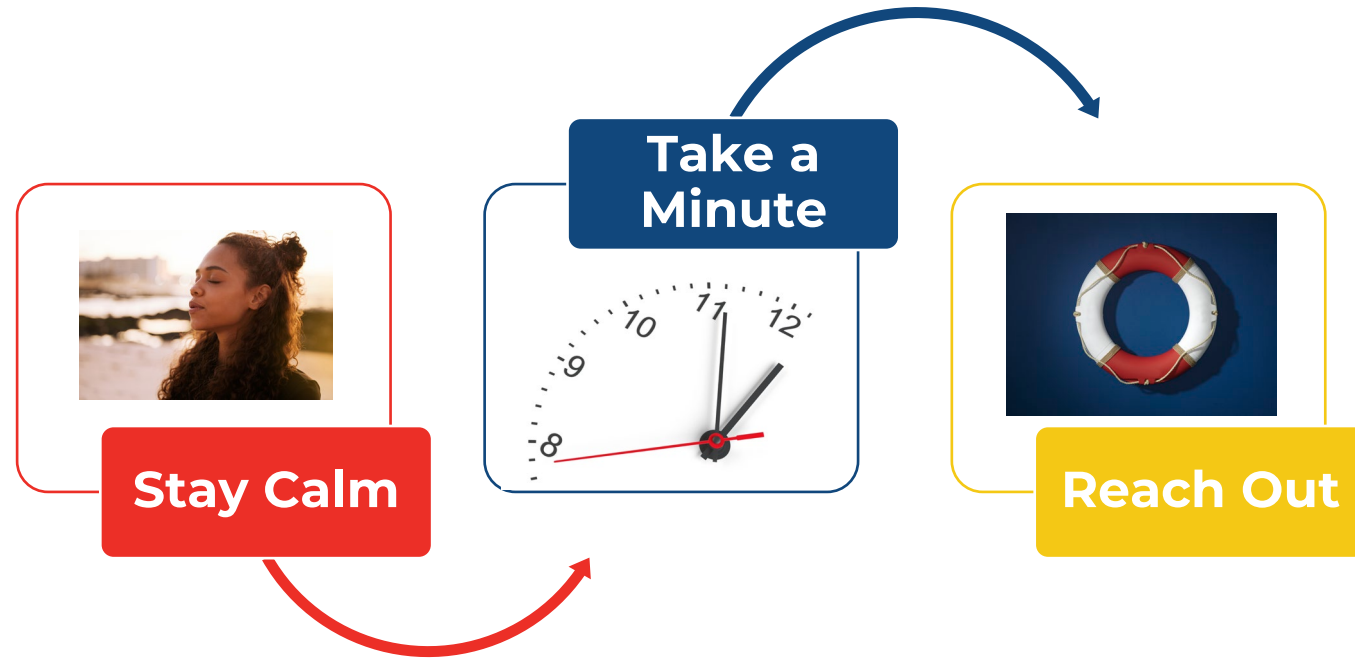

Difficult Situations: Scenarios

Scenario 1: Disclosure of Abuse

You are out with your CASA youth having coffee on a weekend. Your CASA youth says they have something they want to tell you but that they are afraid to. You remind them that your relationship with them is not confidential, but that if they are being hurt or know of someone that is being hurt, it is important they let you know. The youth proceeds to disclose that they are being abused at their current placement.

What do you do?



Scenario 2: Car Accident While Out with Youth

You are out with your CASA youth over the weekend. While you are driving, you are rearended by another car. No one is hurt, but you have got some damage to your car, you are shaken up, and your CASA youth is pretty shaken.

What do you do?



Scenario 3: Accusations Against You

You get a call from CASA staff. They inform you that one of your CASA youth has made a report of harm against you. You are informed that you are being taken off your case while OCS investigates.

What do you do?



Scenario 4: Youth Runs While Visiting with CASA Volunteer

You are out with your CASA youth. When you stop the car to get out at the Zoo, your CASA youth suddenly opens the door and starts running.

What do you do?
