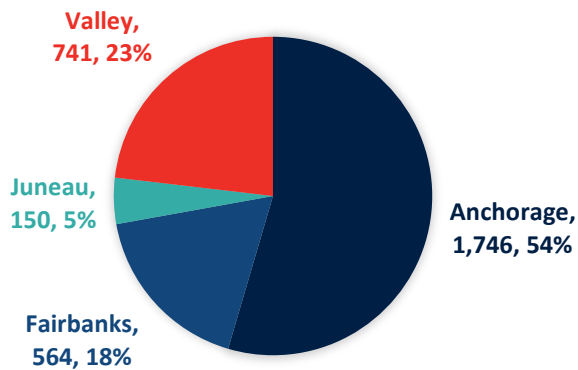

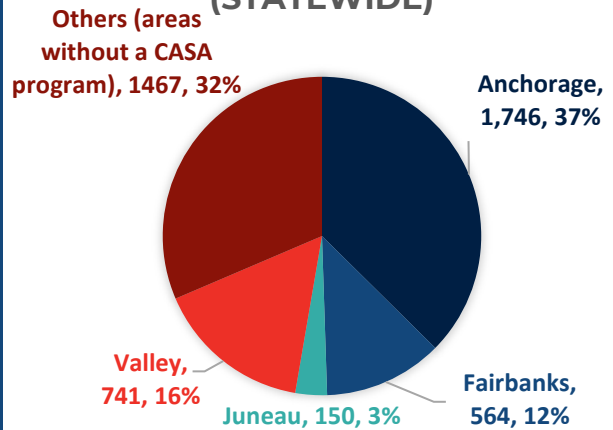
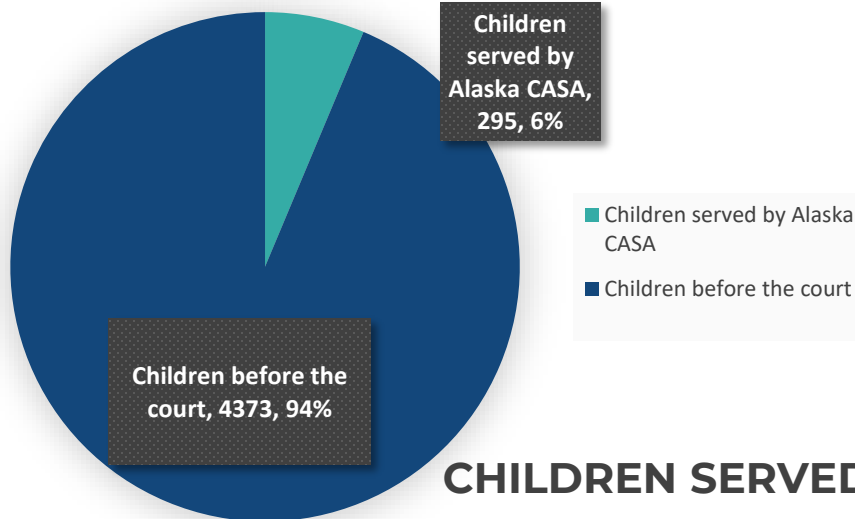


Figure 2 above shows the number and percentage of children before the court in each region, only looking at regions with a CASA program.

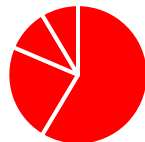

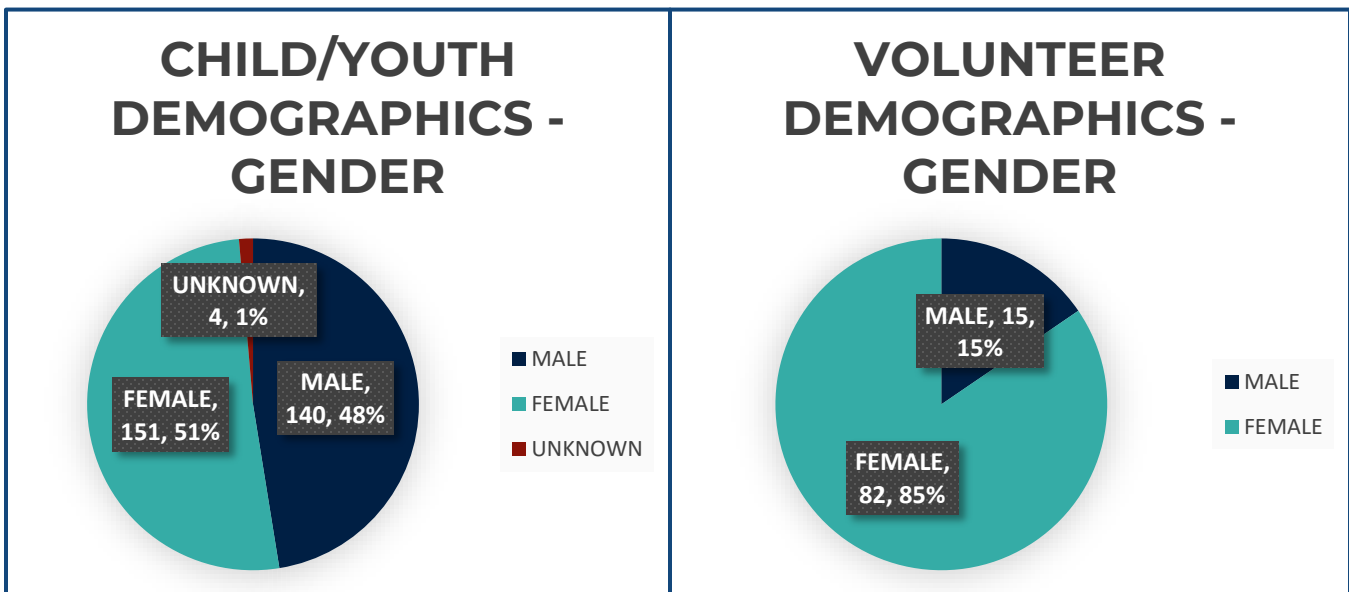

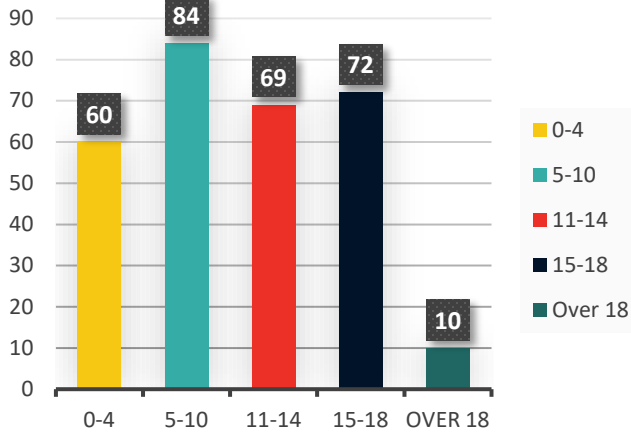

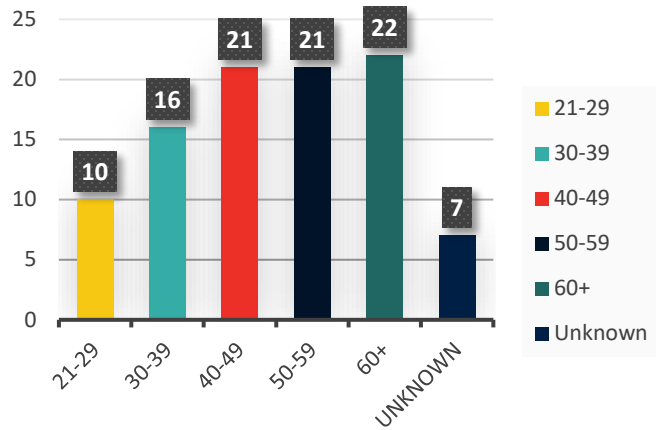

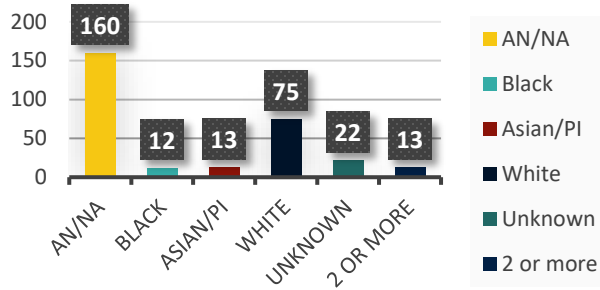
### CHILD/YOUTH DEMOGRAPHICS - AGE



### VOLUNTEER DEMOGRAPHICS - AGE



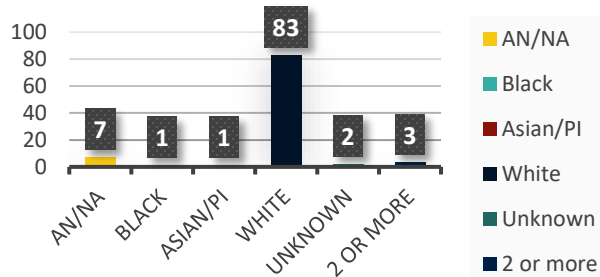

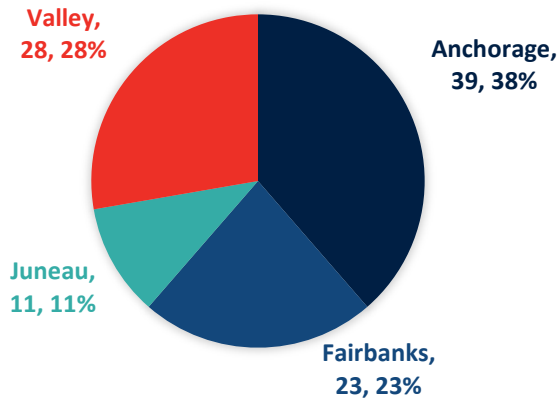

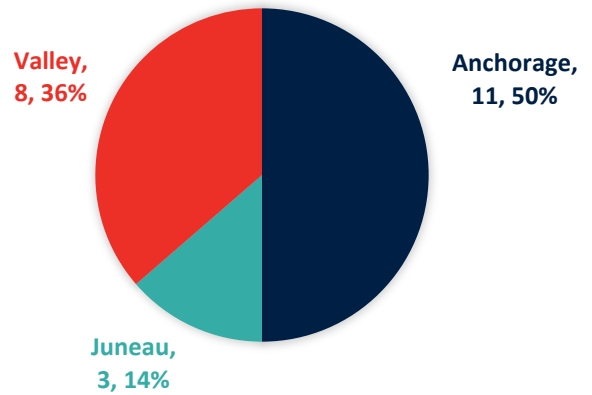

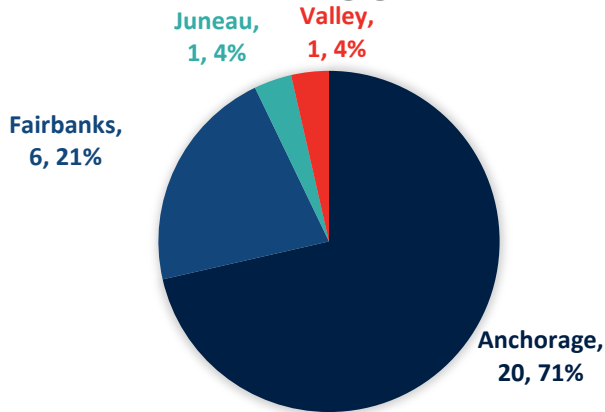
