

What can OCS do for me now? I'm not in custody anymore!



We've got Independent Living Funds for you too!

Am I Eligible?

- Are you under age 21?
- Were you in OCS custody at the age of 16?.

And

 Remained in out-of-home care for at least six consecutive months (beginning at age 16)?



How Do I Apply?

- Contact the Independent Living Specialist for your area and ask for an application.
- The application includes a description of:
 - Your current living situation,
 - Your current work/school situation,
 - Your current involvement in any social/recreational activities,

AND

 An explanation on how financial support will assist you in meeting an independent living goal (such as securing employment, maintaining stable housing, engaging in positive social/recreational activities).

What Do I Get?

You can use IL funds to support you in:

- Housing (must be in care on your 18th birthday)
- Education
- Employment
- Extra Curricular Activities
- Cultural Activities
- Life Skills Development
- * Additional funding can be explored; just ask your IL Specialist!
- * Funds are approved based on what you need, and there are restrictions on how much can be spent.
